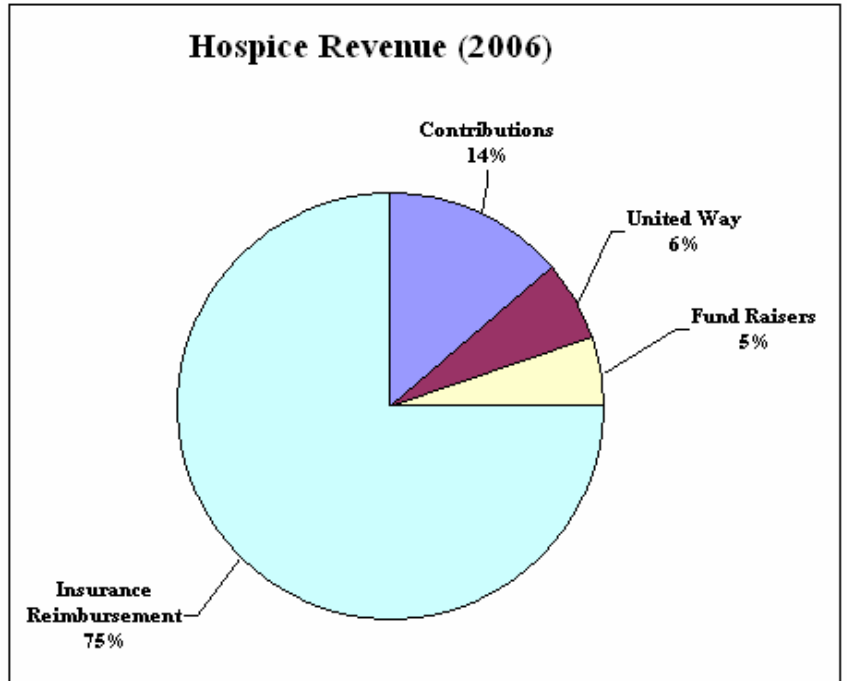

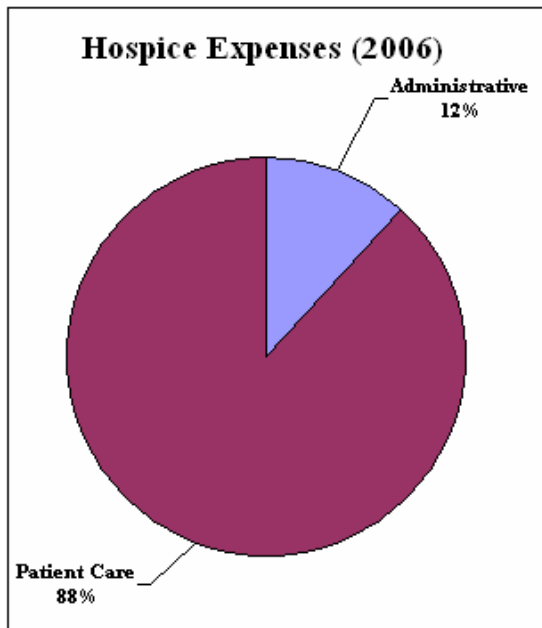
Patients served

In 2006, Hospice provided services to 135 patients and their families. Hospice cared for an average of 13.5 patients per day.



Insurance Reimbursement

Insurance Reimbursement is our primary source of patient revenue. For each patient, Hospice receives a daily insurance rate for patient care. Drug costs often exceed this daily rate.



Community Support

Hospice significantly depends on community support and fundraising efforts to assist in bridging the gap between insurance reimbursement and the actual cost of patient care.
